



Call for ICRE 2023 Chief Residents

Deadline: November 7, 2022

Are you an **International or Canadian** trainee who is passionate about improving training and enhancing patient care? Want the opportunity to share your ideas and expertise with a diverse group of clinician educators and physicians from around the world, who are working to advance residency education?

If you have exceptional leadership skills/experience and social media savvy, and are interested in the planning of and participation in the 2023 International Conference on Residency Education (ICRE), consider applying to be an **ICRE Chief Resident!**

Objectives

ICRE has been offering cutting-edge, practical programming for over a decade that is geared towards those physicians preparing for practice, as well as those currently undergoing training. Now, in order to ensure that our programming truly resonates with our growing international audience of medical education leaders and next-generation physicians, we are on the hunt for two **outstanding** ICRE Chief Residents for ICRE 2023.

As an ICRE Chief Resident, you will act as a representative and advocate for the resident community leading up to, and during, ICRE. The selected candidate(s) will be given the opportunity to contribute a resident's perspective to ICRE programming decisions; collaborate and network with an international group of medical education leaders; liaise with prominent resident groups and obtain critical feedback from other early career physicians; and engage with and produce original content for ICRE's online social platforms.

Roles and responsibilities

The general roles and responsibilities of the ICRE Chief Resident are as follows:

- Participation in monthly planning committee calls with ICRE co-chairs and ICRE Program Advisory Board (approx. 1 hr per call/month), where responsibilities would include providing unique resident input/perspectives around the planning of the upcoming conference with regards to potential sessions, workshops, speakers, etc., and reporting back on any "action" items from previous calls;
- Liaising with resident groups and organizations to obtain feedback and encourage resident attendance at ICRE
- Content creation, including blog posts, social media content, promotional videos, etc.
- Acting as the onsite social media lead during ICRE 2023, where responsibilities would include facilitating questions from the virtual audience during ICRE plenary sessions, and producing/aggregating daily social media content to present during conference plenaries and online platforms; and
- Other subsequent responsibilities as agreed upon between the appointed ICRE Chief Resident and the ICRE planning committee.

Please note: The selected candidate(s) will not receive monetary compensation for their role(s), but will receive financial support to attend ICRE 2023.

Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration, applicants would preferably be in the mid- to senior years of their residency or fellowship training program, and have a strong interest in (and experience with) medical education and social media. Applicants are *not* required to hold the “Chief Resident” position within their own training programs; but must show demonstrable leadership experience.

This year’s application process is open to **International and Canadian** trainees who are currently enrolled in accredited training programs, including residency or fellowship. In their role, the successful applicant(s) will collaborate with the ICRE Chief Resident who is currently serving a two-year term.

We welcome residents from every country to apply, but do require that ICRE Chief Residents have a strong grasp of the English language in speaking, writing and listening comprehension.

Length of term

The selected ICRE Chief Resident(s) will begin their respective term in **December 5, 2022**.

Submission instructions

The following materials are required to complete the submission process:

- A copy of your CV (including PGY (or equivalent), specialty, institution/affiliation, and country of residence);
- A statement of interest (maximum 500 words) explaining why you are interested in becoming an ICRE Chief Resident, and how your experiences to date would make you a good fit for the role;
- A letter of support from your **current** program director speaking to your leadership and/or social media skills as they relate to medical education;
- A 30-60 second video outlining why you think you are the best candidate.

The deadline for ICRE Chief Resident application packages is **November 7, 2022**.
